DARAL D HARRIS "JACK " AGE 63 OF ALTON IL WAS BORN JULY 24, 1961; IN ROSEDALE, MS TO ZITTIE B. HARRIS AND ABRAHAM (LOUIS) KING. JACK PASSED AWAY PEACEFULLY AT HIS HOME ON JANUARY 8, 2025. AT THE AGE OF 9 JACK WAS BAPTIZED AT TABERNACLE MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH IN ALTON IL. ON MARCH 2, 2013 JACK GAVE HIS LIFE BACK TO THE LORD AT MONROE MEMORIAL CHURCH IN ALTON IL.
