Frank relocated to Carlinville, IL with our cousin Maxwell (Butch) Crabb. He loved it there and did very well in that tiny town. He was still employed for the

school district there at the time of his passing. He seemed to develop a chest full of pride working there and his coworkers and the children loved him. Some are represented here today as well as some neighbors and friends.

On the evening of Thursday January 4th Frank entered eternal rest. Praise the Lord, he did not suffer long. He was hospitalized on Dec. 2nd, home by Dec. 8th. He had 3 great weeks with family and friends then he went away with family by his side. He was blessed with 67 yrs. In addition to parents he was preceded in death by a sister Joanie Ellington.
